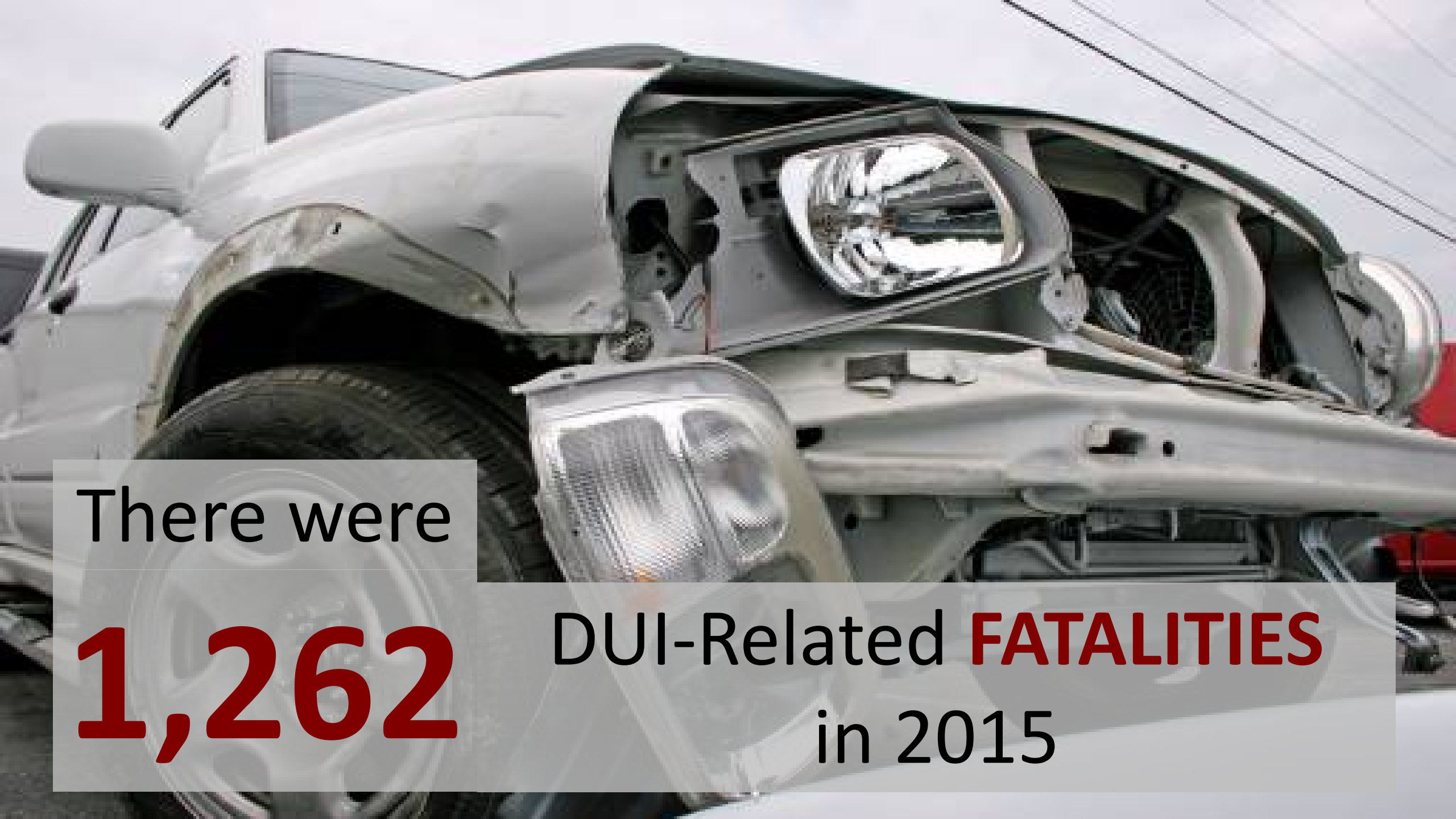

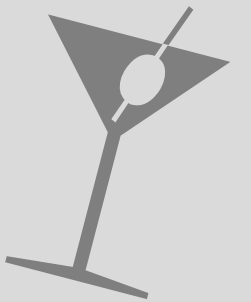

involved **impaired driving** in 2015



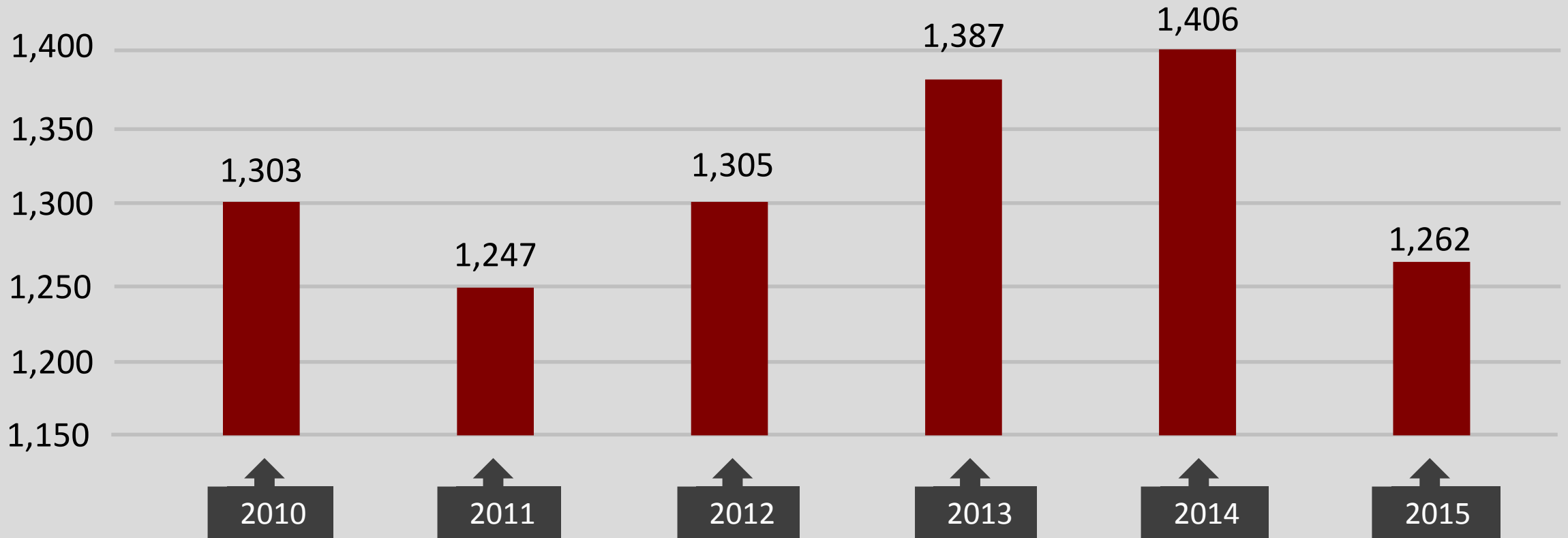

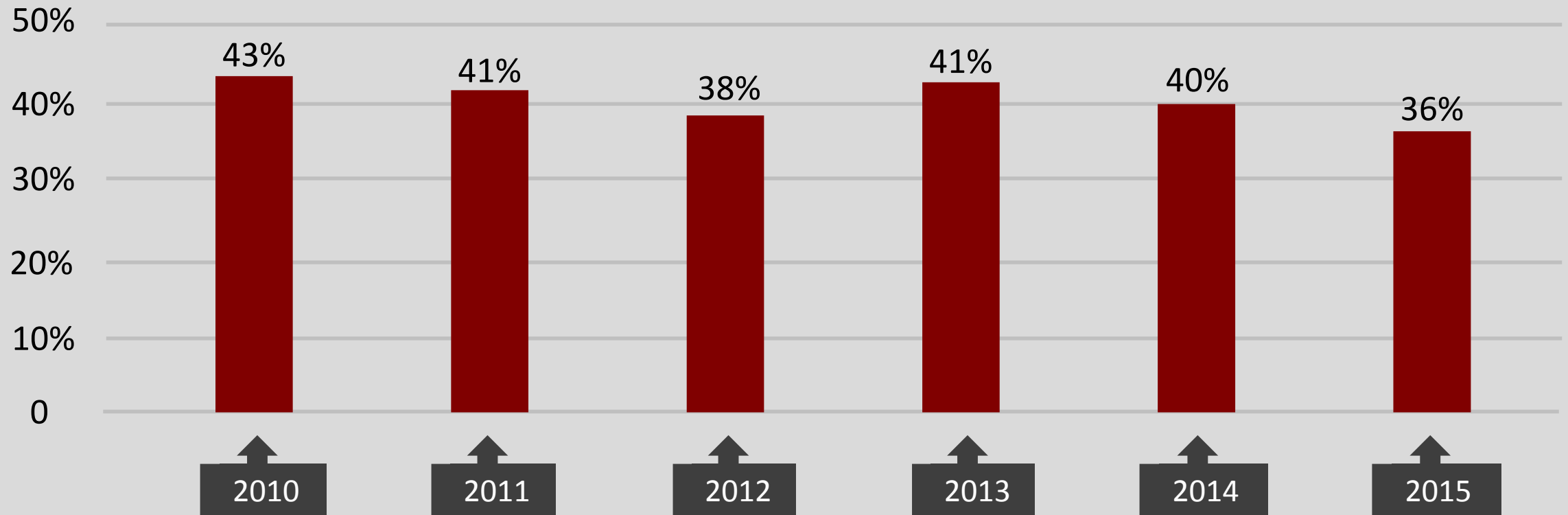

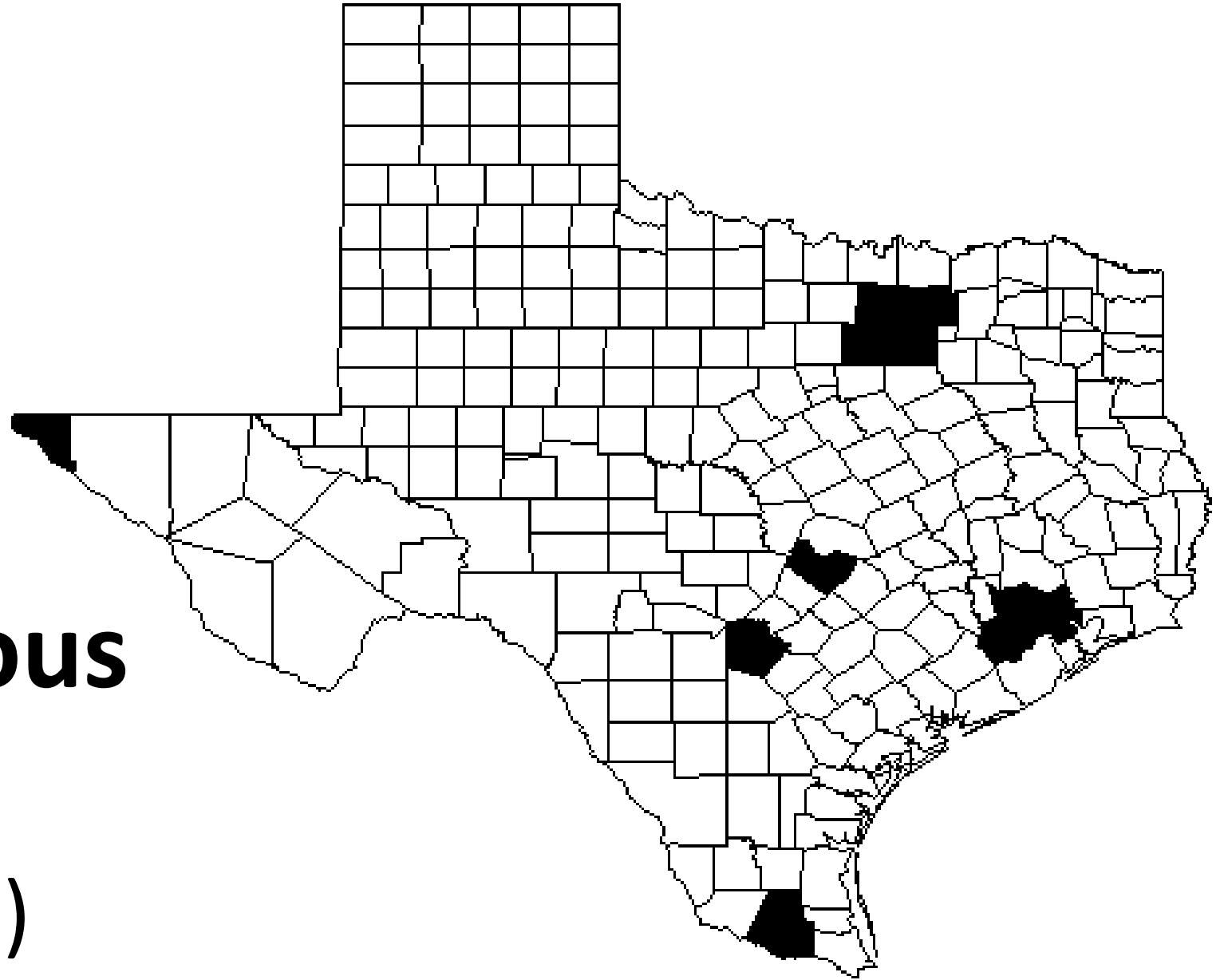

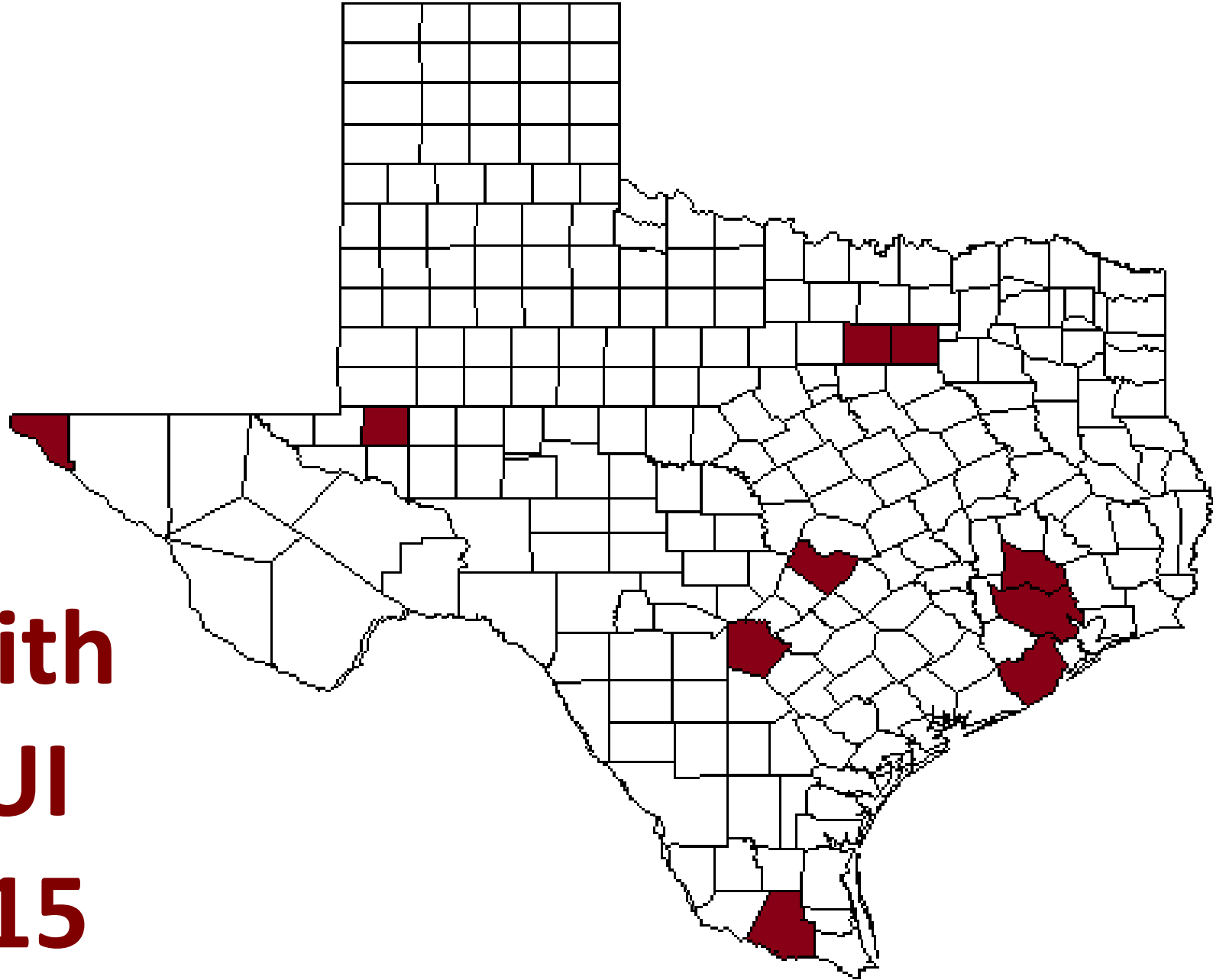

10 Most Populous Counties (2010 US Census)





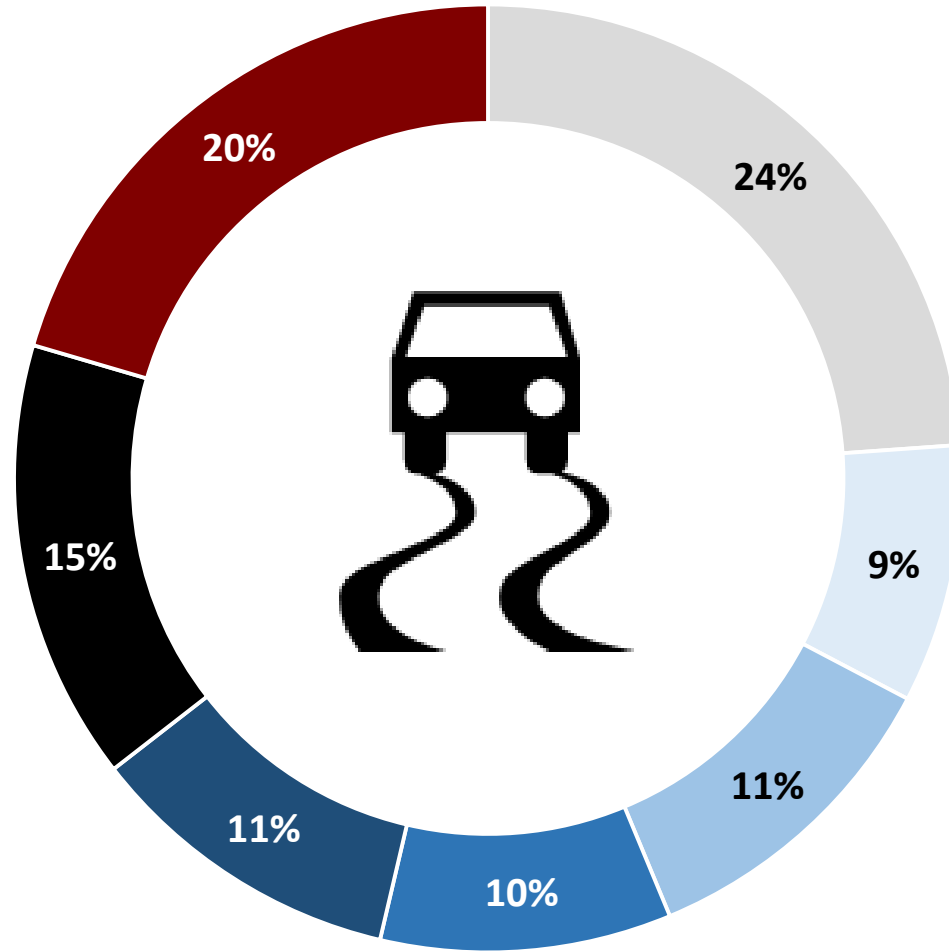

More fatal DUI crashes occurred in the month of **JUNE** than any other month of the year



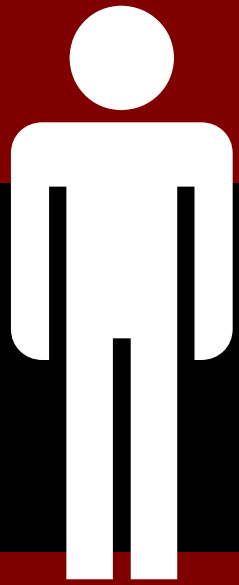

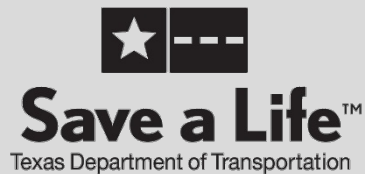

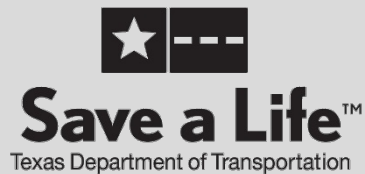

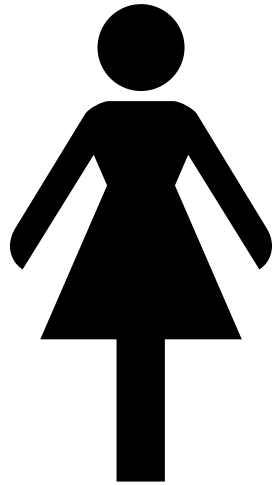

the *AVERAGE* BAC of drivers was **.17**



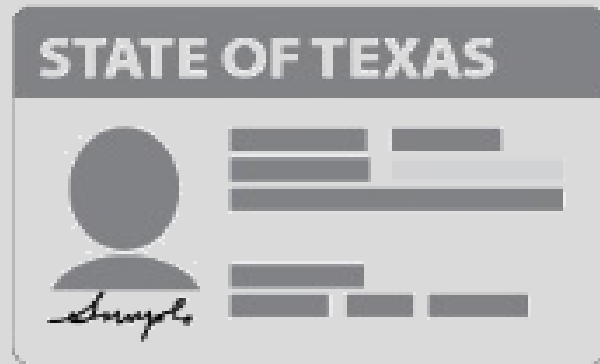
Women *and*
Impaired Driving

In 2015,

156 impaired drivers were
female and **fatally** injured



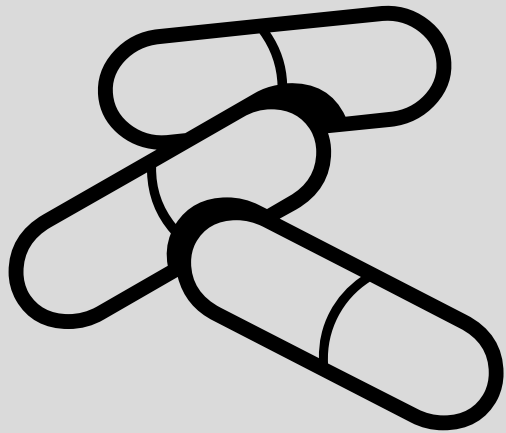
**Women were involved in *19%* of fatal
DUI crashes over the past 6 years**



In 2015 fatal DUI crashes,
WOMEN were *unlicensed* **12%**
of the time



In 2015, female drivers were **NOT** wearing a seatbelt in **38%** of fatal DUI crashes



In fatal DUI crashes over the past 6 years, the presence of CNS depressants was **TWICE** as high in females than in males

MORE crashes occurred

between the hours of

8:00 – 10:00 pm
