
As of November 2016, 8 states (and D.C.) had legalized recreational use of marijuana

As of November 2016, 29 states (and D.C.) had legalized medicinal use of marijuana


In the 85th Legislative Session, approximately 20 bills have been introduced which pertain to marijuana




Geographic Distribution


















Marijuana Beliefs: Marijuana Compared to Alcohol and Tobacco






Marijuana is less safe than alcohol.


Marijuana is less safe than tobacco.

Marijuana Beliefs: Using marijuana makes it harder to think clearly



Marijuana Beliefs: Texas should legalize marijuana for medical conditions




Legalize for Medical Conditions




Legalize for Serious Medical Conditions


Marijuana Beliefs: Texas should legalize marijuana for recreational use



Legalize Recreational by County




Marijuana Policy: There should be a per se level of impairment



It is unsafe to drive after using marijuana




It is unsafe to drive under the influence of marijuana




Marijuana and Driving

Drivers who use marijuana are more likely to be involved in a crash than drivers who don't







