## WHAT IS DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE (DUI) CRASH?

A crash where the driver has a blood alcohol concentration (BAC) result of > 0.00, or had a positive alcohol test, or had a positive drug test, or had a contributing factor of *had been drinking, or under the influence of alcohol, or under the influence – drugs, or taking medication.*

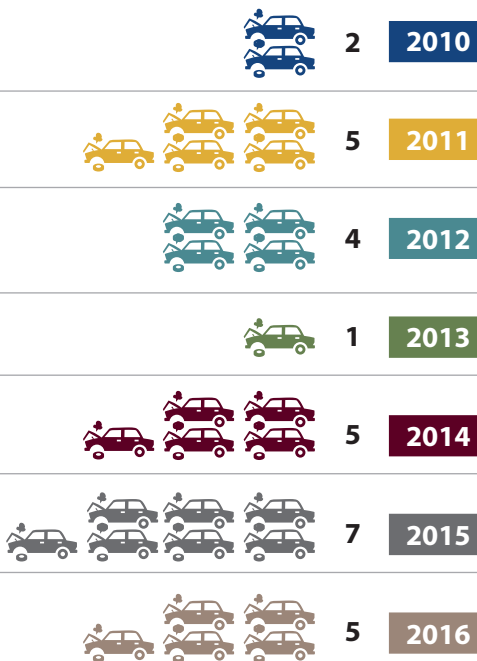

In 2016, there were 0 fatal DUI crashes involving a vehicle colliding with pedestrians, 0 that involved pedalcyclists, and 0 that involve vehicles colliding with motorcyclists.
