

## What is an alcohol-impaired driving crash?


A crash where at least one driver with a blood alcohol concentration (BAC) greater than 0.00 g/dL, or had a contributing factor of "had been drinking" or "under the influence of alcohol." This only includes alcohol involvement, not drugs.





Alcohol-impaired driving fatalities made up **25%** of all traffic fatalities in 2019.

This represents a 9.9% decrease in alcohol-impaired driving fatalities from 2018.





## **OCTOBER 19, 2019**

WAS THE DEADLIEST DAY FOR ALCOHOL-IMPAIRED DRIVING FATAL CRASHES AND FATALITIES IN TEXAS.

There were

11 alcohol-impaired driving fatal crashes

and 12 alcohol-impaired driving fatalities.



Overall, **DECEMBER** was the deadliest month for alcohol-impaired driving fatal crashes and fatalities.


Breakdown of Alcohol-Impaired Drivers Involved in Fatal Crashes by Age:
