2. Anticipated Bills and Bill Categories
  - Marijuana Legalization Bills
    - i. SJR16 (Filed 11/12/2020) – “Proposing a constitutional amendment to authorize and regulate the possession, cultivation, and sale of cannabis”
    - ii. HB447 (Filed 11/10/2020) – “Relating to the regulation of the cultivation, manufacture, distribution, sale, testing, possession, and use of cannabis and cannabis products; authorizing the imposition of taxes and fees; requiring an occupational license; creating a criminal offense...”
    - iii. SB140 ( Filed 11/9/2020) – “Relating to the regulation of the cultivation, manufacture, distribution, sale, testing, possession, and use of cannabis and cannabis products; authorizing the imposition of taxes and fees; requiring an occupational license; creating a criminal offense...”
  - Bills Related to “To-Go Alcohol” and Alcohol Home Delivery Services
  - Bills Related to Sin Taxes for Alcohol and Tobacco
  - Bills Related to Police Reform (or “defunding”)
