Marcie Perez

- Marcie presented 2021 Impaired Driving Crash Data
- In 2021, there were 1210 fatal crashes and 2023 suspected serious injury crashes
 - 30% of crashes involved impaired drivers
- There is an upward trend in in crashes from 2020-2021
 - o In 2021, there was nearly a 10% increase in crashes from 2020
- Marcie presented data by:
 - Day of week, time of day and time of year for alcohol and drugs
 - Gender and age for alcohol and drugs
 - Ped/bike crashes and motorcycle crashes
- Questions:
 - What is the population for rural v urban counties? How does this impact the data?
 - Are crashes in some of these smaller counties involving drivers from the actual county or just drivers passing through? How do certain corridors (e.g. Texas Panhandle to Colorado) impact crash data?
 - How does construction impact crash data?

Discuss and Assign: Texas Impaired Driving Assessment August 16-19, 2022

- Prevention
 - Only one question missing in this section and it will be answered in Round 2. There were several suggestions to include additional coalition members and driver's education.
 - This group's wish would be for there to be greater emphasis placed on prevention – once the impaired driver is in the car, it is already too late.
- Law Enforcement
 - There were no missing questions in this section.
 - This group would like clarification on titles used in the Assessment questions – e.g. "government personnel"
 - The answer to questions will vary depending on how the terms are defined (e.g. state versus local level)
- Criminal Justice System
 - Only one missing question in this section. Clay will provide and answer for this question in Round 2. None of the other questions need additional commentary.
 - This group is ready to testify in August if necessary and answer any follow-up questions in Round 2.
- Program Evaluation and Data
 - This section had 6 missing questions. Larry and Allison discussed who these questions should be assigned to in Round 2. The TRCC needs to be involved in Round 2.
 - TxDPS Toxicologists explained how their data collection works and that other groups may hold more data record information (e.g. TRCC)
- Treatment and Rehabilitation
 - Tara and Charles reviewed the questions in this section and provided additional commentary to some questions.
 - More emphasis needs to be placed on treatment for offenders, particularly on DWI/Drug Courts; evidence based programs
