

Drug Recognition Experts use the following indicators to determine Cannabis impairment:




LACK OF CONVERGENCE: Present



Dilated; Possibly normal

- Possible psychosis






PULSE RATE: Up

- Alteration in thought formation
- Body tremors
- Bloodshot eyes
- Disorientation

- Increased appetite

- Rebound dilation
