DAMON ALLEN ACT (SB 6) ENACTED APRIL 1, 2022



Reforms Bail System

Provides better information to magistrates about a defendant for release on personal bond, such as criminal history, bond condition requirements, and prohibits bail for certain offenses.

Reasonable Conditions

A magistrate may impose any reasonable condition(s) of bond related to the safety of the community and victim of the alleged offense, such as an ignition interlock for DWI cases.

Office of Court Administration (OCA)

OCA is required to provide a Standardized Public Safety Reporting System (PSRS) for statewide use.

Reporting Bond Conditions

Clerks must notify the County Sheriff once the magistrate imposes, modifies, or removes a condition of bond, such as a condition of ignition interlock. The Sheriff's Office must enter the information into the statewide law enforcement database.
