

TxIDTF Prevention Subcommittee | Meeting Notes December 4, 2024 @ 11:00am

- 1. NHTSA Recommendation: Promote and support placement of school resource officers (SROs) in schools throughout Texas.
 - Overview: While placement of SROs is up to individual school districts, the Prevention Subcommittee can support these officers by providing resources and programming.
 - Action Steps:
 - Identify SRO leadership to attend a prevention subcommittee meeting to
 discuss issues they face, their role in preventing impaired-driving, and how
 resources can be utilized to support their efforts to deter alcohol and drug use
 amongst students.
 - Focus on finding an SRO representative with a prevention mindset, as SROs are typically more punitive than prevention-focused.
 - Contact Texas State for training information. Nicole to reach out or share contact details.
 - Explore presenting or sharing a table at the <u>SRO Conference</u> (July 6-11, 2025, Grapevine, TX). Deadline to apply is Feb 15, 2025.
 - Another idea: Transportation training for parking spot lottery at Round Rock
 HS through ODC LMS. If successful at a large school, the initiative could be
 expanded to a district-wide level.
- 2. NHTSA Recommendation: Increase collaboration and integrate the prevention efforts and strategies of local traffic safety programs (e.g., Safe Communities Coalitions) with the strategies of local underage drinking and substance abuse prevention coalitions.
 - Overview: There is a gap between community traffic safety coalitions and youth prevention coalitions. The goal is to bridge this divide.
 - Ideas for Moving Forward:
 - Create an infographic/fact sheet that will align the goals of traffic safety programs and local underage/substance youth prevention coalitions. Align prevention strategies with NHTSA's Countermeasures That Work.
 - Broader focus on behavioral and mental health issues, beyond just substance use and underage drinking.
 - List of stakeholders to invite, along with reasons for their inclusion.
 - SAMSHA guiding principles aligned with NHTSA Countermeasures.
- 3. Cross-Collaboration Opportunity with Cannabis & Alcohol Subcommittee (TABLED)
 - Public education regarding the combined use of alcohol and hemp-derived products.
 - Many well-intentioned individuals may inadvertently consume both substances without realizing the potential for intensified effects and heightened risks.
